Wavertree, launched in Liverpool in 1885, was one of the last large wrought iron sailing ships built. After carrying cargoes to and from ports around the world, she was dismantled in a storm off Cape Horn and used as a floating warehouse in Chile, then a sand barge in Argentina. Wavertree was acquired by the South Street Seaport Museum in 1968.
