This year we will feature a documentary film called *Shipping Out - The Story of America's Seafaring Women*

This unusual documentary tells the history of seafaring women in America. We meet modern women performing jobs in commercial shipping. They work on container ships, tankers, tugs and other vessels, as pilots, engineers, mates and ordinary 'seamen'. "Shipping Out" explores the history, mythologies and attitudes which limited women's participation in seafaring roles until recent times.

Following the film we will feature a panel of 5 women active on maritime vessels including:

Jessica DuLong, one of the world's only female fireboat engineers. Chief engineer on the fireboat John J. Harvey, and is the author of My River Chronicles.

Capt Ann Loeding, tugboat captain, towing barges laden with petroleum products, sand and gravel and heavy equipment in the Atlantic Ocean and many other locations.

Debra Tischler, sailed as second and third mate aboard tankers, bulk carriers and car carriers, before coming ashore to work at one of the largest tanker companies in the world.

The panelists will talk about their maritime experiences and will take questions from the audience.

Following the film & panel there will be a reception with food/beer & wine available. Meet these remarkable women as well as many other women active in maritime trades.
